DO NOT MOW THE NEWLY AERATED AND SEEDED FESCUE UNTIL THE NEW SEEDLINGS EXCEED 4". MOWING NEW SEEDLINGS BEFORE THEY ARE MATURE KILLS THE SEEDLINGS AND RESULTS IN A FAILED SEEDING OPERATION. THIS CONSTANT MOWING AFTER AERATION AND SEEDING IS THE NUMBER ONE REASON FOR AERATION AND SEEDING FAILURE. YOU WILL NEED TO NOTIFY YOUR MAINTENANCE COMPANY TO HOLD OFF MOWING YOUR PROPERTY UNTIL THE NEW SEEDLINGS MEASURE AT LEAST 4" AND NEVER ALLOW YOUR FESCUE TO BE CUT BELOW 3" AT ANY TIME.

➤ WATERING:

Water your seedlings 2-3 times per day for short intervals (about 10 min each) if possible to maintain proper seedling hydration.

DO NOT over water the seeds as pools of water rot and cause disease.

Once the seedlings have germinated and started growing, you may return to your regular 1 time per week for 1" watering routine.

> MOWING:

DO NOT MOW UNTIL THE SEEDLINGS MEASURE AT LEAST 4" Blow off leaves instead of mulching with a lawn mower to avoid disease in your new seedlings.

Once the seedlings have reached 4", mow only as needed and avoid mowing in wet conditions as this leads to tearing the tender seedlings and rutting the wet soil. Continue to maintain your fescue at 3-4" throughout the season to reduce disease issues and turf loss.

We guarantee only that your aeration and seeding is done according to current recommendations and seeding rates. Acts of nature, man and the quality of care afterward is unpredictable and therefore not warrantied. The seed we use is guaranteed to be of the highest quality, purity and germination available. Be sure not to add any seed to the planting as overseeding will add to the possibility of fungal disease problems. IF YOU ARE MOWING TOO SOON, TOO FREQUENTLY OR TOO SHORT, PRESTIGE WILL NOT ACCEPT RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE OUTCOME.

Now that the yard is aerated and seeded, the rest is up to you and Mother Nature. We cannot guarantee what nature has in mind for our fall weather, but the recommendations on this flier will help in making the most of your investment.
